### Waves disappear from inbox when removing a user

Then she can add Bob again and...</li><li>- The wave appears again in the list of the inbox!</li></ul> <p>This bug can provoke that we lose waves easily... If the bug cannot be solved, then better to disable the button for removing users.</p> |        |                        |            |
